Description

I used the following code to extract filenames from an ascii file:

```
f = open(filename)
files = f.readlines()
```

That, however, results in having the string "\n" at the end of each file which prevents tsmerge.py from finding the file. The code should be replaced by

```
f = open(filename)
files = f.read().splitlines()
```
