Monica reports the following:			
I have updated to Ubuntu 20.04 now and have found out the following:			
1) I was hitting a conda bug not specific to ctools which created many conflicts.			
I saw a similar bug reported here: https://github.com/nanoporetech/medaka/issues/117			
This was fixed by modifying ~/.condarc and removing strict: channel_priority: strict Using flexible worked!			
2) I was not able to install ctools with python 3.8 like in my MAC, but python 3.7 worked with the standard instructions in Ubuntu.
