<p>Monica reports the following:</p> <p>I have updated to Ubuntu 20.04 now and have found out the following:</p> <p>1) I was hitting a conda bug not specific to ctools which created many conflicts.</p> <p>I saw a similar bug reported here: https://github.com/nanoporetech/medaka/issues/117</p> <p>This was fixed by modifying ~/.condarc and removing strict: channel_priority: strict Using flexible worked!</p> <p>2) I was not able to install ctools with python 3.8 like in my MAC, but python 3.7 worked with the standard instructions in Ubuntu.</p>
