We have in fact plans to create a platform for High-Energy Astronomy support in the framework of the Virtual Observatory in our lab. In this context, we will have of course web services where all such data can be put. So far we have not yet started to work on setting up platform, but this is somewhere on my todo list.

The advantage of a lab site is that it will be stable, and in addition, there will be support from engineers to run the platform. The web address may be something like <http://ovhe.irap.omp.eu/>. For the meanwhile we have <http://cta.irap.omp.eu/> which is equally stable, and which can be used for downloads.
